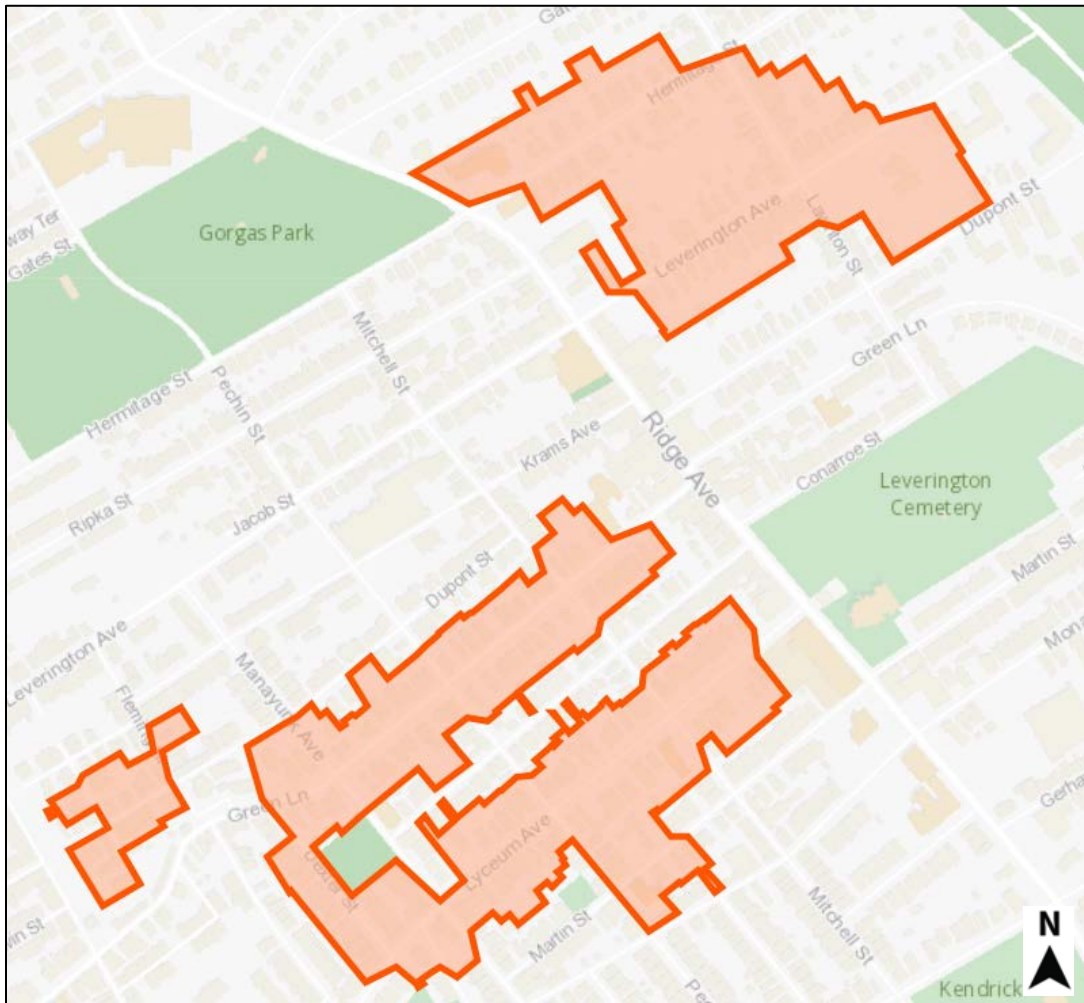


Philadelphia Historical Commission Public Meetings to Consider the Designation of the Victorian Roxborough Historic District

The Philadelphia Historical Commission, the City's preservation agency, will hold two public meetings to consider a proposal to designate a historic district that consists of 343 properties in three clusters of geographic areas in Central Roxborough. The boundaries of the proposed historic district are shown on the map below.
