- There was a good turn out at the shred event in east falls
- There will be a Health for the holidays event on December 16th at 11am 2 pm at North Light where you can get a free screening for diabetes, eye exams, etc
 - There will be a flier going out to the neighborhood.
- At the state level an anti SLAPP bill was passed in the House which allows Judges to throw out SLAP suits faster and allows the RCO to counter sue for a SLAP suit.
- Funding for State Colleges passed in the house with a tuition freeze
- The house passed a bill for a grant program that provides money for security for places of worship, i.e. cameras, better doors, etc
- LIHEAP Home Energy Assistance Program opened November 1st 2023, it is an
 income based home heating assistance program, they have different grants for different
 needs and home sizes. Does not need to be repaid.
